Lamp & Brake Inspection Preparation Sheet

The following items will be inspected on a vehicle requiring a lamp and brake inspection and certification. Any deficiency on any item will result in a failure of that entire system (brake and or lamp system) and a certification will not be issued for that system.

Brake System

- Shoes or linings will be measured and must be within manufacturer's specifications.
- Drums and/or rotors will be measured and must be within manufacturer's specifications.
- All hardware must be present, correctly installed and in working order.
- Hydraulic system cannot have any signs of leakage: including master cylinder, wheel cylinders, calipers, lines and connections.
- Hoses cannot have any cracks.
- Warning lamps must illuminate when they are supposed to illuminate and turn off when they are supposed to turn off.
- Emergency brake must be capable of holding vehicle on a 6% grade.
- Vehicle must be able to stop in less than 25 feet at a speed of 20 mph.

Lamp System

- All originally equipped lighting equipment must be in working order. Please pre-inspect the following lights before your appointment.
 - Headlamps
 - Tail lamps
 - Marker lamps
 - Back-up lamps
 - Brake Lamps (high mount brake lamp if applicable)
 - License plate lamps
 - Turn signals
 - High beam indicator and turn signals.
 - The dome light and instrument illumination are exempt from this inspection.*
- Headlamps must be capable of being aimed as designed by manufacture. All adjusting hardware must be accessible and in good working order. If headlamps are cloudy this must be corrected in order to pass.
- Lenses must be intact with no cracks that would allow white light to be emitted.
- All reflectors must be intact.
- Body damage that interferes with operation of lighting equipment must be repaired prior to inspection.
- Must not have moisture built up on the inside of any glass or plastic lenses.
- If the vehicle is equipped with aftermarket lighting equipment, it must work. This includes fog lamps and driving lamps.
- All lamps must be properly fastened to vehicle and oriented as designed.

This is not a complete list of items that are inspected. Every vehicle is different. Any aftermarket lamps must be D.O.T approved.
